Phillips 66 has agreed to pay \$41,242.00 for use of the workspace, removal of trees and crop loss.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

Phillips 66 is requesting a temporary workspace to maintain their pipeline system on property owned by the City. The original agreement was approved in June of 2020; this amendment shortens the length of the temporary work space but widens the bore pit set up by 20'.
