Re: Tennis Court resurfacing

The Parks & Recreation Department solicited a bid package for the resurfacing of our Nova Pro Bounce Tennis Court which included:

- Using a 4000 PSI Power Washer, removal of all existing dirt and loose material
- Level all low areas with high tensile leveler
- Install (1) coat of acrylic resurface
- Install (2) coats of acrylic textured surface
- Layout and paint lines according to USTA, with 2 coats of textured paint
- Include lines on (2) courts for Pickleball

We only received (2) bids back for the work outlined above because of the surfacing specifications. The contractor is Frazier Davis, which happens to be the same company that installed our tennis court in 2010. Based on recommended maintenance, every (10) years we need to resurface the courts to avoid permanent damage and complete renovation of courts.

This project was approved in March, 2020, however due to Covid-19 and the outlook of funds, we did not move forward with this project and rescheduled for 2021.

The Parks & Recreation Department recommend Frazier Davis at \$27,650 for the tennis court resurfacing project.
