WATSON TRAIL PARK

- Playground was vandalized last week, broke off a handle (under warranty, being replaced) and a small cut to the surfacing.

Athletic Fields

- General maintenance (trash, mulching, etc)

Gempp

- Regular Maintenance.
- Removing invasive including honeysuckle and bittersweet.
- Installing new engineered wood fiber to the trail system.

Lynstone Park

- General maintenance (trash, mulching, etc)

KITUN PARK

- Basic maintenance

Driving Range Area

- Driving Range is doing fantastic; busier every day. Irrigation should be winterized within the next month.

Directors Report

- Continuing to work with committees (Art Committee, Park Board, Pool Advisory, Gempp Commission and Urban Forestry Commission) through email, conference calls and meetings.
