

**RESOLUTION NO. 610**

**WHEREAS**, the Missouri Department of Transportation (MODOT) has announced plans to rebuild the Interstate 44 bridges over the Meramec River just west of Interstate 270; and

**WHEREAS**, public support for bike/ped access led to an agreement with between MODOT and Great Rivers Greenway to fund the bike/ped access on the bridge if the municipalities on either side were able to fund the construction of the bike/ped approaches to the bridge; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cities of Fenton, Kirkwood and Sunset Hills did not have funds available for this project, the Cities submitted a joint application to the Municipal Park Grant Commission and received a special grant of \$1,725,000 for this project of regional significance;

**WHEREAS**, MODOT has let the project for bid, will be awarding the lowest and best bid, construction management, inspections, permits, etc; enter into contract agreement and manage project through its entirety.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City of Sunset Hills will extend their agreement with MoDOT for \$1,513,873.77 (releasing additional \$369,547.99 to MoDOT) to fund the project with the Municipal Park Grant Commission reimbursing the City of Sunset Hills for the amount utilized for the construction of this entire project. The remaining \$48,862.23 will be for future incidentals on the project.
