

**RESOLUTION NO. 613**

**WHEREAS**, as part of the Missouri Highways and Transportation Commission's (the "Commission") construction of the new Interstate 44 bridges over the Meramec River immediately west of Interstate 270, a designated multi-use trail bridge has been constructed by the Commission crossing the Meramec River;

**WHEREAS**, associated with the construction of the multi-use trail bridge being constructed by the Commission, public improvements designated as Route I-44, St. Louis County, Project will consist of constructing multi-use trail connections to the multi-use trail bridge;

**WHEREAS**, the Cities recognize the regional benefit of the multi-use trail bridge and the multi-use trail approaches and it is the desire of the Cities to maintain the multi-use trail approaches and related improvements to provide access to the multi-use trail bridge over the Meramec River; and

**WHEREAS**, the Cities desire to enter into an agreement expressing their mutual understanding and agreement as to their respective obligations to maintain the multi-use trail approaches and related improvements to provide access to the multi-use trail bridge over the Meramec River.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Cities of Fenton, Kirkwood and Sunset Hills will enter into this cooperative maintenance agreement with MoDOT to maintain the multi-use trail approaches.**
