**SUBJECT:** FLOCK Fixed Location License Plate Recognition Cameras

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

\$6,500.00 for the purchase (lease) and installation of two solar powered fixed location license plate recognition cameras with Vehicle Fingerprint technology and real time alerts. \$5,000 yearly service fee, with the first payment due in 2023. The amount requested is within the budgeted amount of \$8,000 derived from unused Proposition P funds. 2022 Legacy Prop P Account:

**BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:**

The funds requested are based on the attached quote provided by FLOCK Safety. It should be noted that our agency currently utilizes and monitors FLOCK cameras in the City of Sunset Hills already. Grandview and Tappawingo Subdivisions, along with Sunset Grove already have privately owned FLOCK cameras in place that our agency has access to and monitors. Future privately owned FLOCK camera sites include Gravois Industrial Court. . It should also be noted that FLOCK Safety is a SOLE SOURCE provider in the St. Louis region for LPR cameras as they are the ONLY LPR camera company that currently has a contract with REJIS, which is absolutely necessary for a police agency. REJIS integration allows for our agency to receive real time alerts for felony and misdemeanor warrants, wanteds, and stolen vehicle information attached to vehicle license plates. It is requested to bypass the city bidding procedures under the policy exception for "Single Source Purchases" per Sec. 2-370 (a) "Exceptions to the purchasing policy".

The proposed locations for the two LPR cameras are eastbound MO 30 between the Meramec River and Rahning Road, and southbound Lindbergh Boulevard just before the entrance to the Sunset Hills Shopping Plaza (pending MODOT approval).

**STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

Based on information presented, staff recommends the purchase of the two proposed LPR cameras.
