

**RESOLUTION NO. 624**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONTRACT FOR 2022 Concrete Slab Replacement Contract AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE THE SAME ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF SUNSET HILLS.**

**WHEREAS**, the City has determined that it is necessary to Replace Concrete Slabs throughout the City; and

**WHEREAS**, sealed bids were received until 10:00 a.m. on May 3, 2022, and were publicly opened and read aloud as follows:

<u>Contractor</u>	<u>Project Cost</u>
M & H Concrete	\$283,111.00
Lamke Trenching	\$349,351.20

**WHEREAS**, following review by City staff, the City has determined M&H Concrete has submitted the lowest responsive bid

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Aldermen of the City of Sunset Hills, Missouri has determined it is in the best interest of the City to enter into a Contract Agreement (the "Agreement") with M&H Concrete for The 2022 Concrete Slab Replacement Project in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SUNSET HILLS, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** The Board of Aldermen of the City of Sunset Hills, Missouri, hereby approves the Contract Agreement with M&H Concrete in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A. The terms of the Agreement shall be substantially similar to, and no less favorable to the City, than the terms reflected within the attached Exhibit A.

**Section 2:** The City shall and the Mayor, City Administrator and other appropriate officers, agents and employees of the City are hereby authorized to execute the Agreement, in substantially the form as Exhibit A incorporated herein by reference, and to take such further actions and execute and deliver such other documents, certificates and instruments as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Resolution.

**Section 3:** The Board of Aldermen authorizes expenditure of funds as follows:

Account #05-5020-9208 in the amount of \$283,111.00

**Section 4:** The portions of this Resolution shall be severable. In the event that any portion of this Resolution is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the remaining portions of this Resolution shall be deemed valid, unless the court finds the valid portions of this Resolution are so essential and inseparably connected with and dependent upon the void portions without the invalid ones, or unless the court finds that the valid portions standing alone are incomplete

and are incapable of being executed in accordance with the legislative intent.

**Section 5:** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
