

RESOLUTION NO. 640

**RESOLUTION DECLARING SURPLUS PROPERTY AND
AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF SUCH PROPERTY**

WHEREAS, the Board of Aldermen has determined that the following described property is surplus property, no longer needed for programs in the City:

- A) Three (3) 2020 Ford Police Utility Interceptor SUVs formerly marked vehicles now replaced with three (3) 2022 models.
- B) One (1) Stalker Radar unit, Purchased in 2005, no longer serviceable or repairable.
- C) One (1) Vigilant License Plate reader system. Unit is outdated, been out of service for 2 years and is being replaced by a new Genetec LPR system in the near future.
- D) Three (3) MasterCom Light Siren Controllers that are out of service, not repairable and will be sold for parts only.
- E) One (1) J-Mar Traffic study device. Replaced by new mobile Speed display and Recording Trailer.
- F) Two (2) TASER X26 devices with cartridges and holsters. These were our 1st generation devices and have been replaced with 3rd generation models.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN
DECLARES THE AFORESAID ITEM TO BE SURPLUS PROPERTY AND
AUTHORIZES THE SALE OF SUCH PROPERTY.**
