FISCAL IMPACT:

Unknown revenue to be generated by auction sales.

Potential revenue of concrete blocks approximately \$780.00 at \$30 per block.

Exercise equipment revenue unknown.

BACKGROUND/DISCUSSION:

Blocks were purchased to create a storage area for the road salt the City received in 2021 while the salt dome at the City campus was under repair. Blocks are no longer needed by the City and are deemed surplus material.

New exercise equipment ordered includes this fitness component as well as many other fitness needs, removing based on space limitations. Free motion lift is twelve (12) years old. Free motion lift deemed surplus property.

STAFF RECOMMENDATION:

Based on the information presented, staff recommends the Board of Alderman deem the blocks and exercise equipment as surplus property. City staff will list the blocks on Govdeals.com and/or Purple Wave auction site for sale. Exercise equipment will also be sold via auction site.
