Laumeier Sculpture Park's upcoming fall event, Laumeier After Dark will be held Saturday, November 5, 2022. Expected attendance for this annual event is approximately 8,000 people. As with other large events in the past, such as Laumeier's Annual Art Fair, we will need to place some temporary signs outside of the park boundaries to facilitate parking, ADA access, and traffic flow. Our plans for signage visible from the street are below and attached.

Three weeks prior to the event, on Monday, October 17th, we would like to place a temporary sign on Laumeier property at the corner of Rott Road and Geyer Road. The sign will have the dates and times of the event.

Beginning Monday, October 31st, we would like to place a One Way notification sign at the corner of Rott Rd and South Lindbergh.

On the day of the event, Saturday, November 5<sup>th</sup>, we would like to place additional directional signage for public parking just outside park property near various entrances.

I have included a signage map to show specific locations for the signage mentioned above.

Your consideration in this matter is greatly appreciated. Please let me know if I can answer any questions. I look forward to your comments and, hopefully, approval of this plan.
