

RESOLUTION NO. 647

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CONTRACT FOR PURCHASE OF A TORO DINGO
AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE
THE SAME ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF SUNSET HILLS.**

WHEREAS, the City has determined that it is necessary to purchase a Dingo; and

WHEREAS, bids were received as follows:

WHEREAS, following review by City staff, the city has determined Luby Equipment has submitted the lowest responsive bid

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF SUNSET HILLS, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Board of Aldermen of the City of Sunset Hills, Missouri, hereby approve the quote with Luby Equipment in substantially the form attached hereto as Exhibit A.

Section 2: The City shall and the Mayor, City Administrator and other appropriate officers, agents and employees of the City are hereby authorized to sign the quote, in substantially the form as Exhibit A incorporated herein by reference, and to take such further actions and execute and deliver such other documents, certificates and instruments as may be necessary or desirable to carry out and comply with the intent of this Resolution.

Section 3: The Board of Aldermen authorizes expenditure of funds as follows:

Account #05.8000.9205 in the amount of \$39,657.00

Section 4: The portions of this Resolution shall be severable. In the event that any portion of this Resolution is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, the remaining portions of this Resolution shall be deemed valid, unless the court finds the valid portions of this Resolution are so essential and inseparably connected with and dependent upon the void portions without the invalid ones, or unless the court finds that the valid portions standing alone are incomplete and are incapable of being executed in accordance with the legislative intent.

Section 5: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
