This is the first year of contracting this activity out. The goal for this year is to seal the joints of all of Ward III concrete streets. This is in effort to prolong the life of our concrete pavement by keeping water from getting sub-surface and negatively impacting the road structure. We have an in-house tar buggy, but by contracting this work out, the Street Department can concentrate on other operations for what appears to be an affordable budget and cover vastly larger segments of the road network with a much more efficient .

We received three bids with the low bid submitted by Sweetens Concrete Services. I reached out to Sweetens and they assured me without a doubt that this project is a separate division of their company from the concrete replacement group, and they do not have near the difficulty in staffing their joint seal operation.

The paperwork for the bid appears in order with Bid Bond. With the favorable response to our concerns by the low bidder, staff recommends awarding this project to Sweetens Concrete Services of Wright City, MO.
