APPROVAL OF THE MINUTES

Mr. Brown provided an update on Day Camp Policies from last meetings discussion, Mr. Brown reported that we would hold number to less than 150 children daily, and no day camps allowed on Fridays.

New Business

A. Update on Capital Expenditures

Mr. Brown gave a brief description of expenditures to date:
Painting - \$16,200; hopefully will start as soon as weather is cooperative.
Diving Board – \$7,800 – purchased and installed.
Drinking Fountain – \$2,500 purchased, being installed.
Computers - \$1,300 – purchased and secured
Restroom renovation – windows, will replace at end of the year
Shed – will be installed at end of the year

B. Review of programs/events/classes

Mr. Brown handed everyone an Activity Guide, walked through aquatic programs.

C. Update on Lifeguards/front desk/snack bar personnel

Mr. Brown explained at this time, we have approximately 45 lifeguards, still looking for 35 -40 more. Front desk/snack bar, have approximately 7, still need 5 more.

Applications are still coming in, just started to advertise through Lindbergh – Peach Jar.
