MINUTES

A motion was made to approve the minutes of the June 18, 2019 meeting by Mr. Epperson and it was seconded by Mr. Schillinger. The motion passed unanimously.

Sgt. Hagen provided an update regarding Community Outreach endeavors which included two scam prevention presentations, one at the Sheridan at Laumeier and the second at the Sunset Hills Community Center, two neighborhood meetings to address the increase in thefts from vehicles and auto thefts occurring in Sunset Hills and throughout the region. A patrol officer participated in the annual LIUNA school supply drive and we participated in the St. Thomas Holy Spirit Church's Back to School night event. The police department had a booth at the 2019 SunCrest Fest and participated in the parade.

Cpl. Lane and Sgt. Hagen participated in the Girl Scouts of Eastern MO's Camp Fury, a one week camp designed to teach girls 7th through 12th grade about careers in the Fire Service and Law Enforcement.

Two Active Shooter training programs were presented to employees of the Holiday Inn Hotel and the Crime Alert email list and Home Security Video list continues to grow.

Stop the Bleed training is being provided to our police officers, with hopes of providing this lifesaving training to the public in the future.

The South Area Public Information Officers Group has been established and includes representatives from local schools, hospitals, police departments, fire districts and long term care facilities.

Mr. Schillinger made a motion to adjourn the meeting which was seconded by Mr. Epperson. The motion passed unanimously and the meeting adjourned at 6:30 PM.
