

Baseball Field Rules and Regulations

1. The City of Sunset Hills events hold priority over any and all field reservations. In the event that your reservation is cancelled due to an over riding city event a full refund will be given.
2. Reservations for residents and non residents will consist of 1 hour blocks of time.
3. All City of Sunset Hills park ordinances apply to ball field use.
4. If your reservation date is **BEFORE May 16th or AFTER Aug 31st** and at least ½ of your practice time goes beyond **6:00pm** then the \$35/hour with lights fee will be applied to the entire rental.
5. If your reservation date is between **May 16th – Aug 31st** and at least ½ of your practice time goes beyond **8:00pm** then the \$35/hour with lights fee will be applied to the entire rental.
6. Groups must leave the grounds clean and all trash must be placed in appropriate receptacles.
7. Fees must be paid in full at time of reservation.
8. In the event a permit fee has been paid for and the registration date is thereafter canceled, the city will refund 50% of the original fee to the registrant, less a \$5.00 handling fee in the event the cancellation occurs in thirty (30) days or less before the event. If the cancellation occurs more than thirty (30) days before the event, the entire permit fee will be refunded less a \$5.00 handling fee.
9. Restitution must be made for any damages by the person making the reservation.
10. All field rentals by outside organizations must submit 1million dollar (\$1,000,000) Certificate of Liability naming the City of Sunset Hills as additional insured.

Park Rules and Regulations

1. It shall be unlawful to drive any motor vehicles, in the City of Sunset Hills excepting on and over and along surfaced and paved driveways provided for that purpose.
2. It shall be unlawful for any person to be in any Sunset Hills City park between dusk and 7:30am or as posted, unless using the Activity Center.
3. Unless otherwise posted, it shall be unlawful to leave, park or stop a motor vehicle on any parking area or drive in the City parks of Sunset Hills after dusk.
4. It shall be unlawful to build fires in any Sunset Hills park except in ovens, stoves or fireplaces provided therein by the City of Sunset Hills. Park patrons may however also use their own portable barbecue braziers in those areas approved by the park & Recreation Commission and so posted. Fire may be prohibited entirely by posting of special notice. Groups are responsible for overseeing and putting their fires out.
5. It shall be unlawful for persons using any park facilities to fail to deposit their rubbish and debris in containers provided for that purpose. All areas shall be left in a clean and orderly condition.
6. It shall be unlawful to solicit any business or service or advertise merchandise, service or goods for sale or hire, except as specifically authorized by the Park and Recreation Commission.
7. It shall be unlawful for any person to use a bow and arrow, crossbow, fire arm, paint gun, or slingshot in Sunset Hills parks at any time except in specific areas which may be designated by the Parks and Recreation Commission.
8. It shall be unlawful to pick any flowering vegetation or to harm any birds or animal life or dig holes in the City of Sunset Hills parks.
9. It shall be unlawful to set off any fireworks in any park except for official displays approved by the Parks and Recreation Commission.
10. It shall be unlawful to operate a bicycle in any shelter or on steps, tennis court, grass areas or trails other than specially authorized areas.
11. It shall be unlawful to swim or boat in any river, lake, pond or stream within the Sunset Hills parks district.
12. The Parks Director is hereby authorized to place appropriate signs marking the prohibitions set out herein.
13. It shall be unlawful to operate a skateboard, roller blades or similar devices in any parks.
14. Glass bottles and glass containers are prohibited in any park
15. All dogs within the boundaries of any park shall be restrained on a leash and the owner shall be held responsible for the animal's actions. Responsibility for sanitary solid waste clean up is that on the owner.
16. No fishing without a Fishing license at Minnie Ha Ha park.
17. It shall be your responsibility financially for any damages at the facilities you reserve.
18. Tables and chairs and other furnishings shall not be removed from the buildings/shelter areas.

Any person who violates any of the provision hereof shall be punished by a fine of not more than five hundred (\$500) dollars and costs, or by imprisonment not exceeding ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
